Please deliver quilts to WLHF, to the church, on Wed. Aug. 8th 1-4pm, Thurs. Aug. 9th 1-4pm or Fri. Aug. 10th 10am- 1pm.

Quilts may be picked up immediately following the show, on Aug. 11th from 4pm- 5pm, Sunday Aug. 12th 1-4pm or Tues. Aug. 14th 10am- 4pm. Please contact us if other arrangements need to be made for delivery or pick-up.

PRECAUTIONS

We will not allow guests to carry food or drinks into the church. Plastic gloves will be handed out at the door, and volunteers will be in the sanctuary and in the lower level to watch over the quilts. The quilts will remain in the church, which will remain locked unless a staff person is there to supervise.

We do not require that the quilts be old or new, or any certain kind. Your story may be about all the places your quilt has been... what it is made of... what it represents... who made it, who it was made for, etc. We would like to see stories for quilts any way we can get them- hand written or typed, arriving with the quilts to be sure we do not display the wrong story with the wrong quilt. Stories are not mandatory, just a fun addition to our show! Stories will be displayed as we receive them; we will not retype or rewrite them! Photos to go with your stories are welcome!
