We are located one mile south of I-80 exit 353. Hotels, camping and restaurants are one mile away, with the city of York just three miles north. Exhibitors receive two free admission passes per booth.

Special Event Admission: \$5 Adults, \$4 Seniors, kids 10 and under are free!

SPACE INFORMATION

Vendor booths are 20'x 20', \$20 per pre-registered booth. Day of rate is \$30 per booth. Each space includes two gate passes. Additional people will pay gate fee to enter. You may reserve more than one booth. Spaces are first-come, first-serve. Booth spaces are clearly marked. Vendors provide their own tables, chairs and shade tents, etc. Benches are located in various places within the swap area for guests and vendors to use. Food vendor booths are the same size, same rate. No electricity.

SET-UP & TAKE-DOWN

Vendor set up is Fri. 10am– 7pm or 6a– 9a on Sat. Booths must remain set up until 4:00 on Saturday. Vehicles not being used as display space must be parked away from booth area after set up; parking spaces are reserved for vendors, with room for trailers.

PERMITS

Nebraska law requires a valid tax identification number. NO alcoholic beverages allowed. NO food or beverages may be sold w/o prior arrangement. NO sale of firearms permitted.

TAXES

Payment of NE Sales Tax is vendor responsibility. Sales Tax rate is 7.5%.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

If you do not have a Nebraska Sales Tax Permit you may obtain one by filing a **Nebraska Tax Application, Form 20**, found online at www.Revenue.Nebraska.gov. It may take two weeks to receive and will be mailed to you.

PERKS FOR VENDORS

Included in your booth fee are pancake tickets. Iced tea and lemonade will be available for vendors in the hospitality tent near the check-in station, located near the swap area along the driveway. Pre-registered vendors will be included in online advertising if registrations are received by July 23rd.

REFUNDS No refunds after Aug. 4th. Rain or shine!

- Modern restrooms on the farm, wheelchair accessible
- Parking shuttle
- Trash cans located in several locations
